### INTRODUCTION

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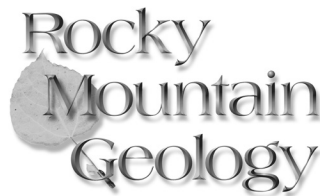
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**COVER ILLUSTRATION:** This photograph was taken from Cottonwood Valley in the southern Portneuf Range, Idaho, looking west-southwest to the southern Bannock Range, where the linear snowfield marks the low-angle Clifton fault (Bannock detachment). Oxford Peak is on the right. The Swan Lake block and Tertiary–Quaternary deposits (middle ground) are underlain by the Valley fault, which is exposed behind the photographer. Stockton Road is in the foreground.

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
